SRECA – 3 Components

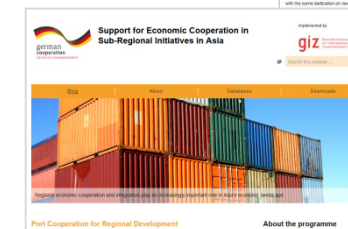


1. **SMEs** have better access to trade-related services including female entrepreneurs (e.g. Export Guidelines).
2. **Structures** for cross-border (sub-) regional cooperation between the focus countries and China are strengthened (e.g. GTI Committees).
3. **Exchange** of knowledge and experience among the focus countries and / or with China in the area of regional economic cooperation has intensified (e.g. Trilateral cooperation).
