### 2022 GIZ-CIQA Training on Cold Chain Management and Agri-Exports to China

#### Background

The SRECA project, implemented by GIZ on behalf of the BMZ has organised multiple activities with CIQA in 2021 to jointly support partners from Cambodia, Lao PDR, Mongolia and Vietnam in export promotion services in the agri-food sector. CIQA and GIZ signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in September 2021, to further support export facilitation of SRECA's project partners in Cambodia, Lao PDR, Mongolia and Vietnam.

#### Virtual Training in 2022

The Covid 19 pandemic has altered cold chain logistic operations: protection of personnel working along the cold chains, intensified sanitary and phytosanitary inspection procedures, and dealing with sudden lock-downs of ports or border-crossings. With China's continuous zero-covid-policy in place, resilient, flexible, efficient and cost-effective cold chain solutions are crucial for businesses trading across borders. To support businesses in Cambodia, Lao PDR, Mongolia and Vietnam better face the cold chain logistic challenges when exporting their agri-products into China, a training on "Cold Chain Management and Agri-Export to China" will be co-organised by GIZ and CIQA. Based on the participants' need and interests, several **topics** can be selected which will be elaborated in-depth by Chinese experts during the training sessions:

- Food Product Cold Chain Management during pandemic – Chinese Policies and Practices
- China's import policies towards varied products along the Cold Chain
- China's Inspection and Quarantine standards for cold chain products during pandemic
- Digitalisation and Cold Chain

#### Targeted participants

Participants from relevant public entities as well as private sector organisations in the field of agricultural export promotion in Cambodia, Laos, Mongolia and Vietnam. Specifically, people who work on cold chain related export promotion services will be invited, the number of participants is to be decided (the scale of the training is to be decided **upon the number of interested participants** from each country).
